For the eIntegrator for QuickBooks Windows Desktop please follow these directions.

1. Download and Install Intuit's interface module QBFC

Download from the below if you have not already done so..

Run/open it. Please follow the prompts taking all the defaults.

2. Download and Install Our program Package

Run/open it. Please follow the prompts taking all the defaults.

NOTE: During the first execution the program will invoke installs of the components that are required. You should take all the defaults to prompts that may occur.

3. Execute the Program

Starting the program

You can start our program via Start/Programs/AaaTeX/eIntegrator or from the desktop icon. QuickBooks should be up and the Admin logged on. (Admin required for 1 time authorization).

For QuickBooks Program Authorization Desktop (Pro, Premier, Enterprise).

5. Activating/Registering the program

After you purchase the program you must Activate it from the *Help, Activation/Registration* menu. You use the information that was entered into our eCommerce system when you purchased the product i.e. Company Name, Phone and PostCode. This is your 'key'.
